New in Version 2.8, Service Release 1

The following new features are available in Service Release 1 for Version 2.8 of the Integration Manager for Microsoft Project:

- **Support for Windows Vista**

Those using Microsoft Project can now use the Windows Vista operating system with the Integration Manager.

☞ Only users with *Administrator* permission on the operating system should install or upgrade the Integration Manager. For those using Microsoft Vista, the *Run as administrator* option should not be used when installing or upgrading the Integration Manager.

- **Support for Microsoft Project Server 2003 re-introduced**

The Integration Manager now supports integration between Web TimeSheet and Microsoft Project Server 2003 once again.

☞ Version 2.7 and 2.8 of the Integration Manager did not support Microsoft Project Server 2003. Support for Microsoft Project Server 2007 was introduced with the initial release of version 2.8 of the Integration Manager.

- **New field mappings in the Std/Pro version**

The following field mappings are now available in the Std/Pro version of the Integration Manager:

From Microsoft Project to Web TimeSheet:


- Project Company to Project Client

From Web TimeSheet to Microsoft Project:

- Task Estimated Cost to Task Cost
- Task Estimated Hours to Task Work



- Project Client to Project Company

 These field mappings were added to the Server version of the Integration Manager in the initial release of version 2.8.

Fixed in Version 2.8, Service Release 1

The following issues are fixed in Service Release 1 for Version 2.8 of the Integration Manager for Microsoft Project:

- The Integration Manager's connection information is now saved in a config file rather than in the registry; Users no longer have to reinstall the application to perform automatic updates after changing their connection information. (58991, 59388)
- If a valid XML settings file is not available, the Integration Manager connection no longer fails. Instead, the Integration Manager now displays a message indicating that no valid XML file has been provided, and opens without any configuration file settings. (49525)
- The double quotation mark ("), single quotation mark ('), comma (,), and period (.) characters can now be included in the names of scheduled actions without causing an error. (59202)
- Any information logged before a user logs in to the Integration Manager is now written to a log file called MSPIWTSConnectLog.txt, typically located at C:\Program Files\Web TimeSheet\MS Project Server\Log Files. (59968)
- On the **Automatic Update** tab in the Server version, negative values can no longer be entered into the update frequency entry options field. (60121)
- In the Server version, when adding a scheduled action, if the user selects the **Every ... week(s)** option from the **Update regularly starting on** field, they are now required to select at least one day of the week before they can save the action. (60120)
- Resolved performance issue that arose when 50 or more projects were transferred from Web TimeSheet to Microsoft Project. (59348)
- A message now displays, and no error occurs, when a user attempts to transfer a project that includes a resource name containing curly bracket ("{" or "}") characters. (59333)
- In the Server version, an error no longer occurs when users attempt to update resources whose names differ in case between Project and Web TimeSheet (for example, **Doug** in Project versus **doug** in Web TimeSheet). (59382, 59329)
- In the Server version, fixed issue that caused an error to occur when the user transferred a project (with **Project Team [Resources and assignments]**, and **Create a new user in Web TimeSheet...** data selected), deleted the project in Web TimeSheet, and then attempted to re-transfer that project using the same settings. (60464)
- The **Select a custom field...** for **login name** and **password** fields now remain enabled when users attach the **Resource Pool Configuration .MPP** file before updating the direction of transfer to Project to Web TimeSheet. (58575)
- The maximum allowed field lengths for transfer from Microsoft Project are now 99 characters for 2003 Pro, and 205 characters for 2007 Pro. (59330)
- In the Std/Pro version, custom fields are now left unpopulated when user cancels the action in Project 2007. (60560)
- In the Std/Pro version, the **Allow mapping of Microsoft Project custom fields** check box is now cleared when the user changes the direction of transfer. (60578)



- In the Server version, when using Project 2003, each time a project is re-transferred from Web TimeSheet to Project, the existing project will now be overwritten. (60618)
- When the user enables the Remember this information check box (formerly called Automatically login to Web TimeSheet server next time), the Integration Manager now saves any updates to the Web TimeSheet connection information, regardless of whether the connection to Web TimeSheet was successful. (59160)
- The Prompt, Continue Transfer and Abort Transfer message options are now working correctly. (59180)
- An error no longer occurs when the user attempts to transfer *Cost, Materials, Budget, and Generic* resources; instead transfer is prevented and a message displays in the log file. These resources are not supported in Web TimeSheet. (62027)
- The failure of a task transfer to Web TimeSheet no longer causes the entire project transfer to fail; if failure occurs, the project transfer will continue with the next task at the same level. (62857)
- If the user attempts to launch the Integration Manager when Microsoft Project is closed, a message now displays prompting the user to open Project. (61243)
- Custom fields are now listed when the Integration Manager is opened from within Microsoft Project (using the **Tools > Web TimeSheet Integration** menu item) for transfers from Project to Web TimeSheet. (61398)
- Users can now open transfer projects without an error occurring after closing, and then reopening Microsoft Project 2003. (61858)
