New in Version 4.0

The following new features are available in Version 4.0 of the Integration Manager for Microsoft Project:

- **Support for Integration with Web TimeSheet 8.2**

Version 4.0 of the Integration Manager is compatible with Web TimeSheet Project & Billing Edition version 8.2 or higher only. The following changes to the Integration Manager support integration with Web TimeSheet 8.2:

- The Integration Manager is now included with Web Timesheet, and can be installed from within the Web TimeSheet interface. Therefore, the *Admin* installation option is no longer available.
- Only users who have permission to enter time against projects (that is, those who have a Project & Billing seat, and *Allow time to be entered against projects* permission) in Web TimeSheet are available for transfer to the resource pool.
- Users newly created in Web TimeSheet are automatically assigned *Project Resource – Billable* permission, if it is available, and *Timesheet* permission, if it is not.
- The *User Default Billing Rate to Resource Standard Rate* field mapping has been added; it replaces the obsolete *User Hourly Payroll to Resource Standard Rate* mapping.

- **Support for Windows Vista**

Those using Microsoft Project can now use the Windows Vista operating system with the Integration Manager.

- ☞ Only users with *Administrator* permission on the operating system should install or upgrade the Integration Manager. For those using Microsoft Vista, the *Run as administrator* option should not be used when installing or upgrading the Integration Manager.



- **Support for Microsoft Project Server 2003 re-introduced**

The Integration Manager now supports integration between Web TimeSheet and Microsoft Project Server 2003 once again.

☞ Version 2.7 and 2.8 of the Integration Manager did not support Microsoft Project Server 2003. Support for Microsoft Project Server 2007 was introduced with the initial release of version 2.8 of the Integration Manager.

- **New field mappings in the Std/Pro version**

The following field mappings are now available in the Std/Pro version of the Integration Manager:

From Microsoft Project to Web TimeSheet:

- Project Company to Project Client

From Web TimeSheet to Microsoft Project:

- Task Estimated Cost to Task Cost
- Task Estimated Hours to Task Work
- Project Client to Project Company

☞ These field mappings were added to the Server version of the Integration Manager in version 2.8.

- **New method of handling users with the same name in Web TimeSheet**

To distinguish between users with the same user name in Web TimeSheet, when transferring such users, the Integration Manager now automatically appends their login name to their user name if the user does not yet exist in the destination application. Duplicate users that cannot be distinguished from one another cannot be transferred.

Fixed in Version 4.0, Service Release 2

The following issues are fixed in Service Release 2 for Version 4.0 of Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for Microsoft Project:

- An error no longer occurs when empty fields are transferred from Project Server 2007 to Web TimeSheet. (64860)

Fixed in Version 4.0, Service Release 1

The following issues are fixed in Service Release 1 for Version 4.0 of Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for Microsoft Project:

- Fixed issue that caused task structure to be transferred incorrectly to Project Server 2007. (64372)
