



Web TimeSheet Billing Integration for QuickBooks Release Notes Version 3.2

Welcome to Version 3.2 of Web TimeSheet Billing Integration for QuickBooks. These release notes provide information on the new features and enhancements that have been included in Version 3.2, as well as known issues that have been fixed in this release. Also included is a list of the versions of Web TimeSheet and Intuit QuickBooks that are compatible with this release.

New in Version 3.2

The following new features are available in Version 3.2 of Web TimeSheet Billing Integration for QuickBooks:

- **Support for QuickBooks 2008**
The Integration Manager now supports the US, Canadian and UK versions of QuickBooks Pro or Premier 2008, QuickBooks Enterprise Solutions U.S. Edition 8.0, and QuickBooks Premier Canadian Multicurrency Edition.
- **Support for Microsoft Vista**
Users can now install and use the Integration Manager on the Vista operating system.
- **Optional truncation of Project to Job data**
Users may now prevent the Integration Manager from automatically truncating Project > Job data that exceeds QuickBooks' maximum allowed field length. This is useful for users who encounter errors when attempting to transfer time entered against projects that were transferred via the Project/Task to (Job and Sub Job)/Item mapping.
- **Ability to select the A/P Account to which Vendor Bills are attached**
When using the Vendor Bills wizard, users may now select which Accounts Payable (A/P) account they would like to attach vendor bills to, from among all available QuickBooks A/P accounts.

Fixed in Version 3.2

The following issues are fixed in Version 3.2 of Web TimeSheet Billing Integration for QuickBooks:

- Client's **Bill Address** now transfers to Web TimeSheet correctly. (58009)
- Ranges for mapped user defined fields (UDFs) are now validated correctly; Appropriate error messages now display if values transferred fall outside the defined range. (57296)



- The Integration Manager now prompts users to use `firstname lastname` name format when transferring vendors to Web TimeSheet if they attempt to use a different name format. (58840, 58497)
- Users can now choose to transfer only billable data to Web TimeSheet by enabling the `Allow only the Billable data` check box. (44180)
- The Integration Manager now ignores tasks against which no time has been entered in Web TimeSheet (that is, now no error message displays) when transferring data to QuickBooks. (58362)
- Fixed issues that arose when a non-admin (who lacked permission to write log/config files) tried to run the integration manager. (59640)
- Vendors with last names only can now be successfully transferred from QuickBooks to Web TimeSheet. (59635)
- Vendors with only first names are now displayed in the **Filtered** list, as expected. (59676)
- In a **Vendor Bills** transfer, the `Accounts Payable` field is now readable in all Windows XP color scheme settings. (59578)
- An error no longer occurs when an **Expense Sheet** user defined field with text exceeding the **Account Name** field maximum in QuickBooks is transferred to **Account/Item**. The UDF entry is now automatically truncated to the **Account Name** field's maximum allowed length. (57137)
- If no accounts payable are available in QuickBooks, users are no longer erroneously allowed access to the transfer page. (59769)
- Fixed issue involving `English (Canada)` regional settings that caused the month and day in an expense sheet date to switch when the user selected **Vendor Bills**, and prevented settings from loading. (58783)
- Fixed low memory issues that caused errors to occur during transfers. (58752, 58753)
- To distinguish between users with duplicated user names in Web TimeSheet, the Integration Manager now automatically appends their login name to their user name when the user does not yet exist in the destination application. Duplicate users that cannot be distinguished from one another cannot be transferred. (60646)
- When **Role Description** is mapped to **Item Description**, roles can now be transferred successfully, whether or not the `This service is used in assemblies or is performed by a subcontractor or partner` check box is enabled. This check box displays when one double-clicks an item in the **Item List**. (59412)
- **Job/Subjob** can now be transferred from QuickBooks to the Web TimeSheet along with **Client**. (47997)

¶ If you are using the Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for QuickBooks for payroll purposes or for automatic client invoice generation, you should not convert to Web TimeSheet Billing Integration for QuickBooks as it is focused only on billing to ensure ease-of-use.
