



Web Resource Release Notes

Version 2.11

Welcome to Version 2.11 of Web Resource. These release notes provide information on the new features and enhancements that have been included in Version 2.11.

New in Version 2.11

The following new features are available in Version 2.11 of Web Resource:

- **Skill Groups**

To make skills easier to find and work with, they are now organized into **skill groups** in Web Resource. For example, you can now create a skill group for each type of resource in your organization, such as *Developers*, *QA Analysts*, and *Technical Writers*. Or, you can create groups for types of skills, such as *Language Skills*, *Programming Languages*, *Tool Skills*, *Communication Skills*, etc. You can create any number of skill groups and any number of skills within each group. You can continue to add skill levels for each skill.

 **How existing skills will be migrated to version 2.11**

When you upgrade to version 2.11, all skills that exist in your system will be automatically added to a skill group called *Skills*. You can then create new skill groups and assign your existing skills to those groups, if desired.

- **Intuitive End Date Defaults**

In previous versions of Web Resource, for most date fields, if you edited a start date, the end date would not update, which required project leaders to update the end date field manually with each change.

Now, if you edit the start date for projects or time off bookings, the end date will automatically update so that the existing duration is retained. For example, if you change an assignment's start date from May 3 to May 6, its end date will automatically move back by 3 work days, say from May 10 to May 13. In addition, if you enter a start date for a new assignment or booking, the end date will automatically update to match the start date you entered. You can of course still edit the end date manually.

- **Support for Internet Explorer 8 and 9**


You can now use Web Resource with version 8 or 9 of Internet Explorer.

Other Changes

- **Web Resource 2.11 only supports use with Windows Server 2003 with Service Pack 2 or higher (32-bit version only)**

As of Web Resource version 2.11, support for the following operating systems has been discontinued:

- Microsoft Windows 2000
- Microsoft Windows XP Professional
- Microsoft Windows Vista Ultimate, Business, or Enterprise
- Microsoft Windows Server 2008
