New in Version 2.8

The following new features are available in Version 2.8 of Web Resource:

- **Ability to exclude time off from project allocation**
Administrators can now specify, in **System Preferences**, that time off data not be used when calculating project resource allocations.
- **Improved filters**
The following improvements have been made to the filters in Web Resource, to improve ease of use:
 - Filter settings are now saved for each user between Web Resource sessions. Users must generate the report for settings to be saved.
 - Each filter now contains a reset button. When selected, this button resets the filters, and, if applicable, the calendar date and width to the default values.
 - The **Resource Name** filter has been improved. Users can now filter by a user's full name, or text contained in a user's first name only or last name only.
 - On the **Edit Project** page, the **Advanced Search** for task assignment resources now includes an **Availability at Least %** filter, which allows users to search for resources to assign to a project by their percent availability. This replaces the **Show Available Resources Only** filter.
 - **Resource** filters are now available in the **Project Team Calendar** and on the **View User Time Off** page.
- **Visual indication of new resource allocations**
When the user adds resources and placeholders to a project, they are now highlighted.
- **Duplicate time off bookings now prevented**
Users can no longer make two time off bookings against the same time off type on the same day.



- **Support for SAML authentication**
SAML is an XML-based standard for exchanging authentication data that allows users to employ web browser single sign-on. It is typically used as an enterprise-level identity management solution.
- **Users now prompted to save when attempting to exit the Project Edit page**
- **Skills and Categories now display in separate columns in Resource Details and Resource Availability exports, to improve ease of use**
- **Support for Firefox 3.0**
- **Support for Windows Server 2008**

 Web Resource version 2.8 is compatible with Web TimeSheet Project & Billing version 8.2 and 8.3 only.

Fixed in Version 2.8, Service Release 1

The following issues are fixed in Service Release 1 for Version 2.8 of Web Resource:

- Editing system preferences no longer causes the system to change to built in authentication for those not using SAML authentication. Now, the system will only change to using built in authentication on save if the user is disabling SAML. (63746)

Fixed in Version 2.8

The following issues are fixed in Version 2.8 of Web Resource:

- If the user selects the **Publish to Web TimeSheet** link from a project page, and then selects the **Cancel** button on the **Connect to Web Timesheet** page that displays, the project page now displays, as expected. (61161)
- Task durations now remain within the limits of the project duration when adding users to projects that fall entirely on a weekend. (63120)
- Fixed issues that prevented categories, resources, time off types, skills, and projects from displaying correctly in list views after the user edited the number of records per page to 1 (and, in some cases, deleted a list entry). (63079, 63110, 61028, 61029)
- An error no longer occurs when the user selects the browser's "back" button after transferring all users from Web TimeSheet to Web Resource. (62524)
- The **Web TimeSheet Integration History** (accessed from the **Web TimeSheet Integration** page) now opens in a new window, allowing any selected integration settings to be saved. (64089)
- An error no longer occurs when the user attempts to upload two license files with the same name; a message now displays instead. (61088)
- In the pop-up that displays when the user hovers over project entries in the **Allocation Calendar**, tasks are now listed from highest to lowest allocation percentage. (61141)
- **Resource Availability** report now includes a **Group** field. (61760)
- When the user adds a resource to a project, the start date of their task now defaults to today's date if today's date falls between the project's start and end dates. Otherwise, the task start date defaults to the project's start date. (63045)
- If the user selects a task from the **My Calendar** page, and then selects **Cancel** on the **Edit Project** page that displays, Web Resource now returns to the **My Calendar** page, not to the **Resource Calendar**. (60562, 61280)
