



## What's New In Web TimeSheet 5.6

### Administration

- New Actions in Permissions  
Three new actions have been added to the **Add/Edit Permission** screen under the new **Integration** heading:
  - "Override permissions to allow exporting of all data in Web TimeSheet" allows you to override the user's existing permissions for the purpose of exporting data from Web TimeSheet to an external application via the integration manager (e.g, Microsoft Project). For example, if the user has the ability to edit only his own projects in Web TimeSheet, enabling this action will allow the user to export data for all projects in the system via the integration manager.
  - "Override permissions to allow importing of all data in Web TimeSheet " allows you to override the user's existing permissions for the purpose of importing data into Web TimeSheet from an external application via the integration manager. For example, if the user has the ability to edit only his own projects in Web TimeSheet, enabling this action will allow the user to update any projects in the system via the integration manager.
  - "Can authorize integration applications" allows you to specify whether a user can enable/disable the connection from an external (installed outside the Web TimeSheet server) integration manager to Web TimeSheet. To perform updates via the external integration managers, the connection must be enabled (see Setting Up the Integration Manager for further information about enabling/disabling the connection).
- WTS Integration Manager for QuickBooks (XML) Moved  
The link to access the Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for QuickBooks (XML) has been moved from the **Administration** menu to the new **Integration** menu. Also, the action associated with this link has been moved from the Administrative actions to the Integration actions on the **Add/Edit Permission** screen.

### Projects

- Number of Task Levels Increased to Ten  
The project structure has been enhanced to allow up to ten task levels (previously allowed four).

### Journals

- Journal Functions Moved to Projects Menu  
The following items have been moved from the **Journals** menu to the **Projects** menu for the purpose of consolidating all project-related functions:
  - Add Project Notes
  - List Notes by Project
  - List Notes by User

- Journals Menu Removed  
The **Journals** menu has been removed to consolidate journals with project functions.

## Integration

- Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for Microsoft Project  
The new Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for Microsoft Project® allows users to update project/task information, project team assignments, and timesheet data between Web TimeSheet and Microsoft Project Server 2003 easily and efficiently. Once installed, the Integration Manager is accessible from the Web TimeSheet folder in the Start menu on the employee's local machine.

The Integration Manager allows one-way transfer of timesheet/hours data from Web TimeSheet to Microsoft Project. Bi-directional data transfer is available for project/task information and project team assignments. Bi-directional project/task information includes:

- Project/task structure
- Project leader
- Estimated cost (tasks only, with roll-up to the parent level)
- Task start/end dates

The project/start end dates can be transferred one way, from Microsoft Project to Web TimeSheet (these dates are automatically determined in Microsoft Project based on the task start/end dates).

The Web TimeSheet Integration Manager of Microsoft Project is available for Microsoft Project® Server 2003.

- New Integration Menu  
A new **Integration** menu provides access to integration-related features including integration setup, access to the Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for QuickBooks (XML), and links to download/install local copies of the Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for Microsoft Project.
- Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for QuickBooks (XML) Moved  
The link used to access the Web TimeSheet Integration Manager for QuickBooks (XML) has been moved from the **Administration** menu to the new **Integration** menu.
